LEED® Gold Certified Building

The home of the Institute of Materials
Science, construction on Science 1 was
completed in 2022 and the building was
certified LEED Gold in 2023. The building
was constructed as part of the Next
Generation Connecticut initiative and
boasts 198,000 sq. ft. of new age
laboratory space and equipment. Both the
building and the surrounding grounds
have many sustainable features!

Year certified: 2023

76% (774.2 tons) of construction waste diverted from landfill

74% reduction in energy use compared to baseline (<u>Payette</u>)

Green features of interest:

- 500 kW rooftop photovoltaic (solar) panel array
- Bioretention gardens that store and clean stormwater runoff
- Triple-plane window glazing that helps reduce heating or cooling losses
- LED fixtures and occupancy/vacancy motion sensors
