LEED® Gold Certified Building

UConn Hartford is home to UConn's Law program and has won multiple awards, including the 2017 Connecticut Preservation Award from the Connecticut Trust for Historic Preservation. The west entrance to the campus is the historic Hartford Times Building - built in 1920 - where four different presidents have given speeches. The building was certified LEED Gold in July of 2019.
