LEED® Gold Certified Building

Werth Tower, formerly known as NextGen Hall, was certified Gold in 2017. Werth is home to eight different residential learning communities (housed on each floor), including EcoHouse, a community of students who are passionate about the environment. The building hosts a range of green features, including a green roof and solar panels.

Year certified: 2017

97% of construction waste recycled (747 tons)

20% of building material used was recycled content



Green features of interest:

- Green roof garden
- Solar thermal collection
- High performance window glazing and solar shading devices
- Light colored roofing and pavement surfaces
- Water bottle refill stations
- Advanced thermostats that can detect open windows
